What do we do on Purim Katan?

We don't read the *megillah*, nor is there any special mitzvah to send food portions to friends or give gifts to the poor, as is the case on Purim proper. The Shulchan Aruch cites an opinion that one should increase in festivity and joy, but rules that there is no halachic obligation to do so. "Nevertheless," the Shulchan Aruch continues, "a person should increase somewhat in festivity, in order to fulfill his duty according to the opinion that it is obligatory." By way of explanation, it concludes with the above quote from Proverbs: "One who is of good heart is festive always." Joy and festivity are always desirable; so, if an opportunity presents itself in the form of a day that might have been Purim—the most joyous day of the year—one should certainly rejoice and celebrate.
