Commemorate the giving of the Torah at Mount Sinai, 3338 years ago

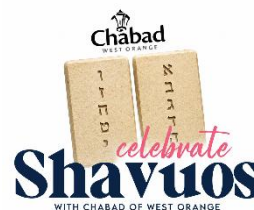
Our **All-Night Learning** program will once again partner with Congregation Ohr Torah, this year hosted at CWO. It
